

NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

Burbank Channel Bikeway Project

The City of Burbank will be considering the approval of property acquisitions for the Burbank Channel Bikeway Project. The proposed project is a $\frac{3}{4}$ -mile dedicated bike and pedestrian path located directly adjacent to the Burbank Western (flood control) Channel. The proposed project will expand the City's bicycle network as a high-quality bicycle and pedestrian facility, as well as enhance the condition of the channel.

Where is proposed project located?

Beginning at the Downtown Burbank Metrolink Station, the project will proceed south along the channel to Alameda Avenue. The 12-foot wide path will include controlled local street crossings at Olive Avenue/Flower Street, Verdugo Avenue and Providencia Avenue/Lake Street and a signalized grade crossing at Alameda Avenue. This project will also extend the Phase I portion of the project that was completed in 2011.

Purpose of the Meeting

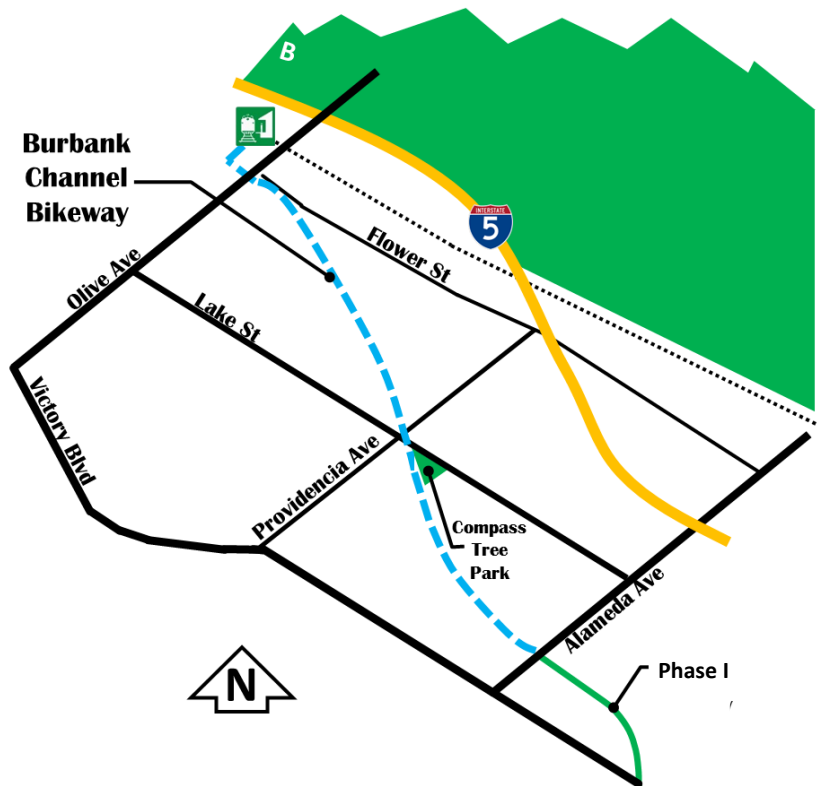
The purpose of the meeting is for the Burbank City Council to consider approving agreements to acquire property rights for the Project.
